

Dog Park Amenities

- Park is divided into 2 enclosed areas.
 - Aprox. 1 acre designated for large, active dogs over 25lbs.
 - Aprox .5 acre designated for small, less active, older, or shy dogs.
- Drinking water for you and your dog.
- Picnic table and benches
- Trees and landscaping
- Agility equipment on the large side

Safety and Security

- Key fob required for electronic entry through the safety gates
- When membership expires or vaccinations are past due, key fob will no longer allow entry.
- 4 foot perimeter fence with double gated entries and exits
- Monitored by Scottsburg Parks & Rec staff and Animal Control
- Routine grounds maintenance is scheduled for Mondays, weather permitting.

Fees & Registration

- Household annual fee: \$25 for first year, \$15 for each year after
- 1 membership includes up to 4 immunized dogs at the same residence
- All dogs must be registered as a dog park member to enter
- **Must produce vet documentation of up to date required vaccinations listed with expiration date.**
- Review, agree to, and sign the acceptance terms.
- Once registered at Scottsburg City Hall, a key fob is issued for access to the safety gate.
- The yearly registration will be valid starting on the date the dog(s) are registered until the anniversary date.
- Replacement key fobs are \$10.

Health Requirements

- Dogs must be spayed/neutered and at least 4 months of age
- **Vaccinations required: Rabies, Bordetella (kennel cough), Distemper, Parvovirus**
- Strongly recommended but not required: negative stool sample for parasites and monthly parasite prevention

Rules for Dogs & Owners

1. Dog owners are solely and legally responsible for their pets' actions, behaviors, and security.
2. All patrons and their dog(s) use the park at their own risk.
3. Infants and children under 12 years of age must have adult supervision.
4. All dogs must display on their collar a rabies and ID tag.
5. No open fires permitted.
6. Do not bring your dog to the park if it is sick, contagious, or injured.
7. 1 person is required to be present for every 2 dogs.

8. Only unleash your dog inside the dog run area, and carry the leash with you at all times; 1 leash per dog is required; all dogs must be leashed outside the fenced area.

9. Handlers must scoop the waste and dispose of it properly, and they must fill any holes dug by their dog.

10. Handlers must have their dog in sight at all times.

11. If your dog becomes unruly, plays rough, or becomes aggressive, leash the dog and leave immediately.

12. Dogs known to exhibit vicious, aggressive, or dangerous behavior are not permitted.

13. No smoking, drinking alcohol, eating or glass containers permitted.

14. Do not bring food bowls, dog food, toys, or chew rawhides. Small, concealed training treats are permitted.

15. It is permissible to bring a fetch toy, such as a tennis ball, as long as it does not provoke other dogs.

16. No animals other than dogs are permitted in the dog park.

17. Spiked/Pronged/Pinch collars are not allowed.

18. You must NOT grant entry to unauthorized users of the dog park or privileges will be revoked.

19. The Scottsburg Parks & Rec Department reserves the right to close the park at it's discretion.

20. No overnight camping.

21. Do not feed treats to other dogs.
